

## OTHER CAPITAL NEEDS:

- Finish a dormitory which will house 80 of the 160 children we minister to, allowing us more influence over them to disciple them. Most children live with a guardian who is not a good influence for them (typically from Islam or witchcraft) in a village 3 miles away.
- Purchase the land next to us which is currently being excavated for soil for bricks. This is causing the foundation of our existing buildings to be weakened.
- Build a chicken coop to allow us to grow chickens and eggs to enhance the nutrition to the children and sell to support the orphanage.

If you would choose to partner with us for one “Mango Sunday” per year for the next three years, we are confident these projects will be completed and we would be able to be completely self-sustaining within 3 years of planting.
